The after-hours phone is connected to and answered by an afterhours registered nurse, who will assess your needs, offer advice, or arrange immediate assistance from the on-call doctor or rural nurse. (The triage nurse may take a few minutes to answer.)

### Wellness Checks

Are you due for your annual wellness check or never had one?

These are completed over two visits and on the first visit blood tests are done with the practice nurse and a consultation with the doctor. You will have a follow up visit with the doctor to discuss results. The first GP appointment is for 30 minutes and the second GP appointment is for 15 minutes with one fee to cover both. If you would like to make an appointment, please phone reception to arrange a time.

### Stop Smoking

If you would like to stop smoking or would like support on reaching your goal to becoming smoke free, please contact us at the Health Centre to talk to the Practice Nurse or make an appointment. The GP can also refer you to a fully funded service to support, offer free replacement therapy and help you to become smoke free.

### Lab Costs & Tests

Please be aware that if you are an overseas visitor or on a work visa that is valid for less than 2 years, you will be charged for blood tests or any other test and any laboratory charges that are incurred.

Please also be aware that If you request a blood test that has not been requested by the Doctor for medical reasons it will incur a fee.

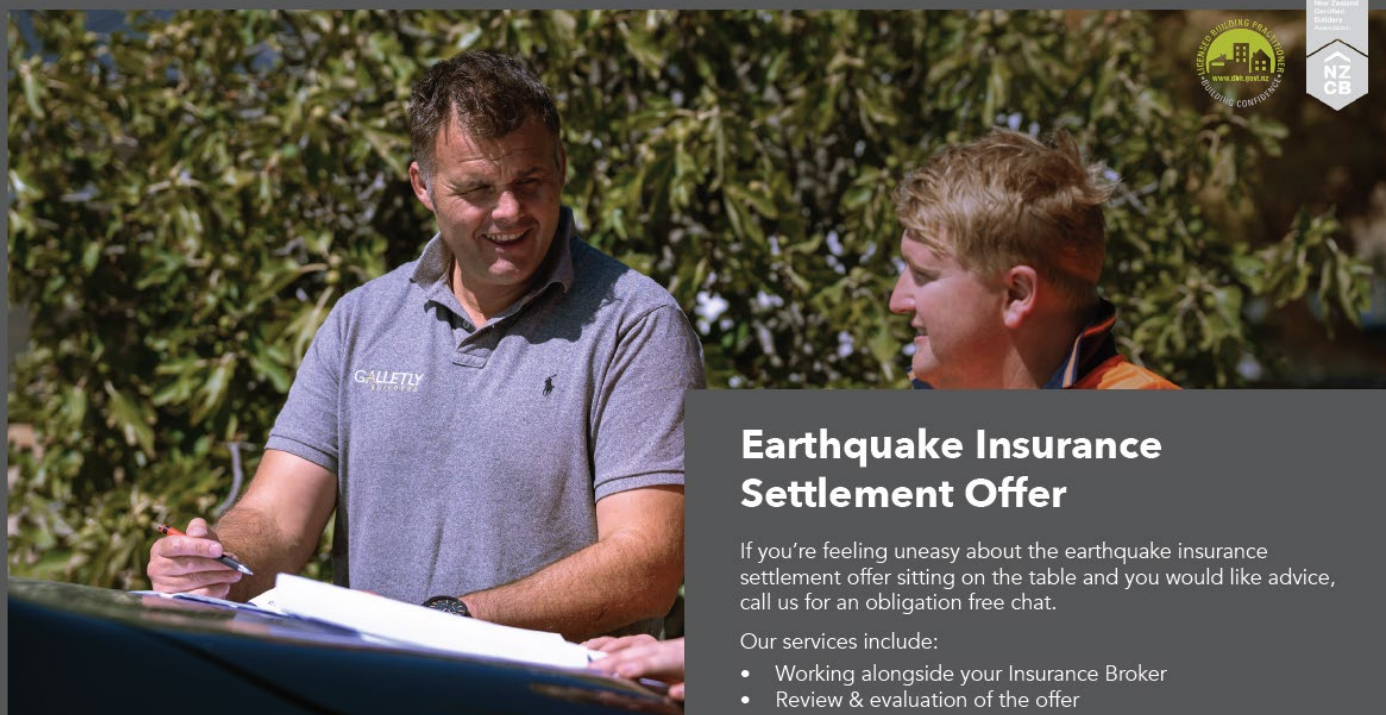
