## **Become a Surf Lifeguard**

This year Nelson Surf Life Saving Club will start the Surf Lifeguard Award Training Course on Sunday the 23rd of September.

## Qualifying as a Surf Lifeguard

To be a qualified lifeguard you must be 14 years or older and pass your Surf Lifeguard Award exam. The exam comprises:

- 400m pool swim in under 9 minutes
- run/swim/run in the surf
- resuscitation test
- rescue test
- theory questions
- practical surf knowledge test

All training sessions will be on either Sunday afternoons starting at 2pm or Thursday evenings starting at 5pm. Sessions will run for about an hour and a half each, with the first session being held at Riverside Pool to test our swimming.
