<u>Reminder:</u> On Semi-finals Day - There will be **NO** draws. When the buzzer sounds for the end of the game, blow your whistle, call "umpire's time" & ask the player to "hold the ball". <u>Check the score.</u>

If there is a winner (score is not tied) - give a long blow on your whistle to signal the end of the game.

If the score is tied, play is to continue until one team is ahead by TWO goals. Giving a short whistle, recommence play.
