#### Item #1: Reminders

1. Playoff Ties: the team ranked the highest after round robin will win any tied games in play offs.
2. Hoop Height: Bounce 8ft, Mini 8ft, C2-5 Pro 9ft C1 10ft, Allstar 10ft Hoop.
3. Ball Size: Bounce Size 5, Mini Size 5, Pro Size 5, Allstar Boys Size 6 and Girls Size 5.
4. Monday 29<sup>th</sup> August will either be a spare week if we have snow or a finals night. (13<sup>th</sup> week of competition).
5. Mouth Guards are compulsory for all players U19, referees will not let players take the court without one.

#### Item #2: Max 4 dribbles

#### Item #3: Girls Got Game League

We are continuing GGGL for Girls to play in on a Thursday afternoon alongside their school team. We are preparing Gold Rush players to head this league. They will coach and run games on an allocated court. Girls can enter both this and their school team. Teams will be selected without school allegiances in mind. A separate form will be sent out for players to register for the GGG League.

**Item #4 Dispensation**

We would like to have all players that want to play, playing. We can offer dispensation for players without a school team to join another school. If this could be communicated early and we can all work together to organise it would be best. If this does not work we can also offer an older player to play down an age grade if there is no team for them to play in for their school, again this needs to be communicated before season gets underway. **Item #5 Glory league**

Glory league is set up for this season and is used on all full court games. Players and their families will be able to watch replays and highlights of games, send game clips to family members who cannot watch in person. This is a fantastic development for BBO and Sport in Otago, especially during these uncertain times and spectator limitations, and this service is provided as a part of the team fee. With this system, players will need to be registered with their family email and therefore this means parents should be registering their children rather than the schools to ensure they can benefit from this exciting opportunity.
