Refuse and Recycling over Christmas and New Year

There is no change to the refuse and recycling collections in Culverden, Rotherham and Waiau over Christmas and New Year. Please remember the following.

- Only official Hurunui Council bags will be collected.
- Bags must be securely tied and at the kerbside by 8am as collection times may vary to normal.
- Refuse bags must not exceed 15kg in weight.
- Bags split prior to the crew's arrival and non-official bags will not be collected.

The following are accepted, providing they are clean and loose in a Council recycling bag.

- Newspapers, magazines, office paper and telephone directories.
- Cardboard, greetings cards, junk mail, envelopes and egg boxes.
- Food, drink and pet food cans.
- Rigid plastic bottles and small containers, types 1, 2 and 5 only with lids removed.

Bundles of cardboard will not be collected from the kerbside; these need to be taken to Councils transfer stations to be recycled.

Glass bottles must not be put in recycling bags but can be recycled via any transfer station providing all lids are removed.

What cannot be recycled?

Soft plastics (i.e. those that can be scrunched in your hand), plastics numbered 3, 4, 6 and 7, tetrapaks, polystyrene (including meat trays), plant pots, clothing, shoes and food waste are not recyclable.

If in doubt throw it out as recycling bags containing contaminants will be stickered and left.

Recycling wrapping paper and cards

Wrapping paper and cards can be recycled but remember we cannot recycle foil and glittery wrapping paper, glittery cards, ribbons, bows and tape, as these will contaminate recycling.

Where to purchase Hurunui Council refuse and recycling bags?

Official bags can be purchased at Culverden Four Square, Rotherham Store, Waiau Hardware and Amuri Service Centre.

Transfer Station Arrangements

All transfer stations are closed on Christmas Day, Boxing Day and January 1 and 2. Normal hours apply at all other times. Amberley transfer station will also open on Tuesday 29 December and Tuesday 5 January from 10am to 4pm.




