Hillmorton High School is holding its annual Year 12 and Year 13 formal in the Tī Kōuka room at Haere-roa (the University of Canterbury Student Association building) on Saturday 21 August.

Doors will be open for students from 7:00 pm and will close at 7:30 pm. If students choose to leave the venue, they will be unable to return.

There is a generous drop-off and pick-up area, along with free parking in the adjacent carpark.

This year's theme is 'Enchanted Forest'. The theme is used to decorate the venue in preparation for a memorable evening. It is optional for students to dress to this theme.

Tickets are \$70 per person. This covers food, drink, photographer, photo booth, DJ, security, decorations and prizes. The food provided throughout the evening is finger food and not a full meal. No alcoholic beverages will be available, and the students should arrive at the venue sober.

We are very grateful to UCSA for providing the venue to us for no charge, in recognition of our relationship with them through the Ka Ora Ka Ako (healthy school lunch) programme.

Students are permitted to bring a partner to the formal. The partner must be Year 11 or older. All attendees (students and partners) are required to obey school rules. School reserves the right of admission refusal (ROAR). Any attendee arriving under the influence of alcohol and / or drugs with not be allowed entry and their ticket will not be refunded.

Further information regarding school rules will be issued to students. The school does not condone 'after parties' and does not take any responsibility for them. Ms Brokenshire will send out information from the NZ Police regarding after parties closer to the date.

All payments need to be made by Friday 13 August. They can be made at the school payments office in cash or by EFTPOS (no credit card), or by bank transfer. If payment is made by bank transfer, please indicate clearly the student's name and that the payment is for the formal.

Door sales will not be available on the day and students will need to show their ticket to gain entry.
