



Future secondary education provision in the Rolleston area




There is ongoing and projected growth in the Rolleston area, meaning that additional secondary provision will likely be required by 2025. This stage in the engagement process follows an earlier engagement that occurred in the second half of 2020. This engagement is to determine how additional secondary education can best meet the rapidly growing population of Rolleston and the surrounding area.

The first stage in the engagement process determined that there are two preferred options. These were to have a new Year 9 – 13 independent state secondary school with its own enrolment zone, or to have a second campus of Rolleston College separated by junior and senior students. Participants in the process asked for more information on each option:

1. New independent state secondary school - Participants wanted to know where this would be located and what the enrolment zone could be.
 2. Second campus of Rolleston college separated by student age – Participants wanted to know how

the two campuses would operate, and what teaching and learning would be like.



In this second stage of the engagement process we will provide more information on the above aspects which may help influence your preference and feedback around these options. Your feedback based on this information will help us determine which of these two options is preferred by the community.
