

## If your services are Vaccine Pass Only, then...



Have as many people as you like, as long as they have a vaccine pass.

Note: This applies to any people using any church venue, or to any church meeting anywhere.



Go ahead with hospitality!

That includes bread AND wine at communion if you are OK with that. Give people the option of bread only, though. And check-out our hospitality check-list to be safe.



**Encourage Mask Wearing!** 

Compulsory for anyone doing face-to-face ministry like greeters.



Everyone SCAN IN (or sign in) and show your pass.

Signs on the door, pew bulletins, emails, phone to those without emails...




Find a way of caring pastorally for those who can't come.

## If your services are mixed, then...



Attendance is limited to 50 people, 1m apart.

1m means some churches can't have so many! You have a plan.



Sorry, no food or drink served!

Of course communion bread is allowed. Take it back to your seat to eat. Try to get everyone to use sanitiser before taking it.



Sanitise the building before and after services.



Masks MUST be worn.



Everyone SCAN IN and use hand sanitiser.



Let people know, any way you can, what services you are offering.
