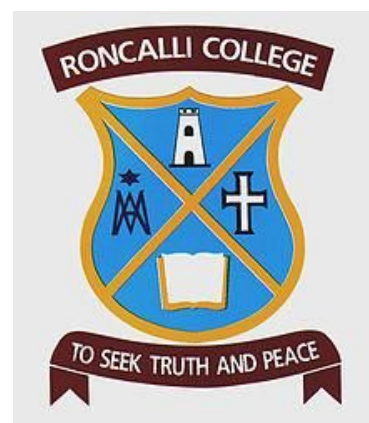


# Southern Catholic Secondary Schools' Senior Sports Tournament 2018

## **Facilities**

### **Control Room**

The meeting room on left hand side of stadium entrance. Displayed in here will be results and draws.

**Please come to this area if you have any questions**

- **Netball** MLT Stadium, Synpave courts 3 & 4
- **Basketball** MLT Stadium, Wooden Sprung Court 1 and Synpave Court 2  
Students may change in the available changing rooms.

**For your own protection please do not leave your personal items in the changing rooms.**

- **Hockey** MLT Hockey Turf

The Hockey Pavilion has two changing rooms. Teams may use these before games to get ready. Please ensure belongings are removed from the changing rooms prior to your game beginning. Preference for changing rooms goes to teams playing the next scheduled game on the turf. Other changing facilities are available in the stadium.

- **Rugby** Pioneer Rugby Grounds 1 & 2

Four changing rooms will be available at Pioneer for the rugby teams to use for games. This should allow teams to leave their belongings in the changing rooms while playing.

- **Football** St Peter's College Fields 1 & 2

Students will use the school changing rooms at the end of the gym on the Sunday. On Monday due to school two classrooms will be available for changing, and the bathrooms will still be available in the gym.

# Food

## Dinner Sunday

Dinner will be served buffet style in the school hostel 'Rosmini House'.

- Please ensure students arrive at their allocated time only. This has been arranged to fit around the draw and to fit with seating arrangements.

## Food

### ➤ Officials and staff

Food, baking and hot drinks will be available at the control room at the MLT stadium from 1pm Sunday and from 10am Monday. This is available free for staff and adult officials/umpires only. Students will also be bringing supplies around to each venue periodically over the two days.

### ➤ Lunch Monday

Individual lunches will be packed for each student. These will be available for each school to collect their allotted numbers from 11.30am on Monday.

### ➤ Additional food available

The MLT Stadium and Esplins Dairy ( North side of St Peters on Robertson St) will have a selection of hot and cold food available for purchase during the event.

A coffee cart will be moving between the different locations over the two days.

## Mass

Mass will be held at 7:30pm at the Gore Catholic Church on Ardwick St.

Each school's buses can meet students in the bottom car park on Robertson St at 7:15pm. If schools make other arrangements it is up to your school to advise your students and staff of this change.

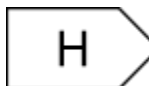
Parking options, please note for Monday there will only be space in the MLT stadium car park for buses.

School quad for opening ceremony. Buses may park in the school car park off Robertson St during this time, following this they would be best to move to the MLT stadium.



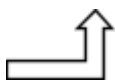

# Points and Trophies

## **Southern Catholic Secondary Schools Senior Sports Tournament Champion Trophy**

School points will be calculated off the final placings of each team at the end of the tournament. Schools will calculate their top 7 points and will drop the points for their lowest placed team.

Schools that do not have a team in an event will use this gap as their lowest placing. All other teams in the event will move up the table leaving the 5th place slot empty.

School Championship points will be awarded as follows

### **Points will be awarded as follows**

- 1<sup>st</sup> place = 5 points
- 2<sup>nd</sup> place = 4 points
- 3<sup>rd</sup> place = 3 points
- 4<sup>th</sup> place = 2 points
- 5<sup>th</sup> place = 1 point.

### **Individual Sports Champion Awards.**

In 2014 trophies were introduced for each individual sporting event.

The school or schools with the highest points at the end of the round robin will be the winner of these new trophies.

### **Interschool Awards**

Schools that have formerly held school exchanges will this year be able to reintroduce these for 2018. These points will be calculated for the two individual schools.

All award winners will be presented with their prizes during the closing ceremony.

It will be the responsibility of each winning school to retain, engrave and maintain the trophies to be returned for presentation the following year.
