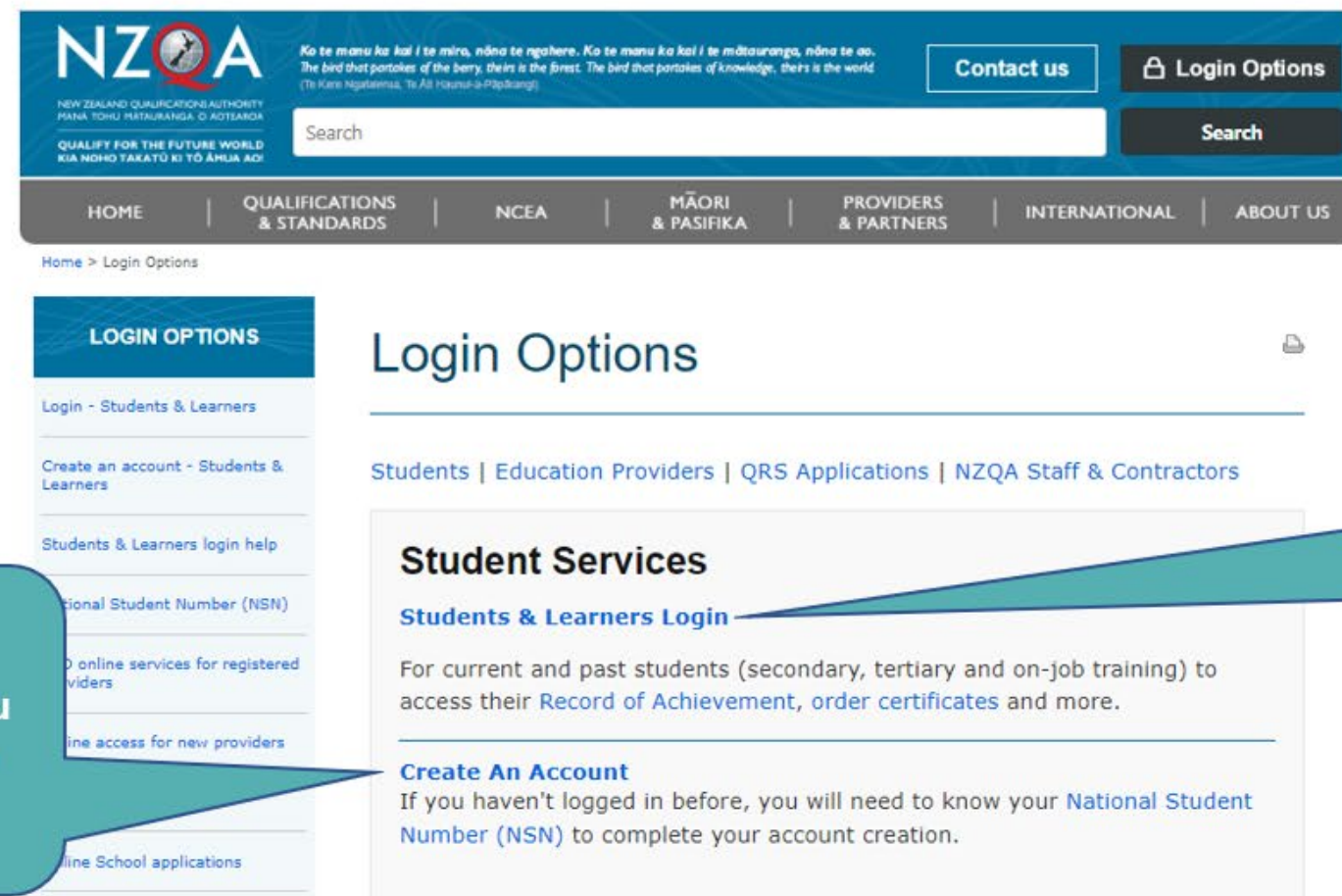



Understanding your Summary of Marks

Each standard is made up of 1 or more questions.

- Each question for a standard is awarded a grade score.
- For example, the grade scores below are added together to give a total score of 8:
 - Question 1: N2 (2 marks)
 - Question 2: NR (0 marks)
 - Question 3: M6 (6 marks)
 - Total score = 8 (2 + 6).

Your total score does not automatically determine if your result is a Not Achieved, Achieved, Merit or an Excellence.

To determine your result for the standard, we use something called cut scores.

Cut scores:

- are the number ranges for a Not Achieved, Achieved, Merit, and Excellence
- separate where results fall.

Each standard in an exam could have different cut scores. And the cut scores might change each year. Senior markers determine the cut scores for each standard.
