- We will treat others with respect and refrain from negative or disparaging remarks or conduct.

- This includes respecting basic human rights; that is, the equal rights of every person involved in sport including but not limited to no discrimination, whether on the grounds of gender, race, colour, language, religion, political or other opinion, national or social origin, association with a national minority, birth or other.
- Abstain from the use or consumption of any illegal products including alcohol, smoking and vaping at sporting events and venues.
- At all times, be honest and act in the best interests of self and others.
- Be the best version of oneself and grow the legacy of the Kura.
- When touring or away, there is to be no alcohol, drugs or behaviour that directly impacts the schools' image or our values. If such occurs, students will be removed and sent home to face disciplinary action at the expense of parents/caregivers.
