PARKING GUIDELINES

Drop Off and Collection of Students

(p10 Parents' Information Booklet)

Parents dropping off students must ensure that they see their child entering the school gate no earlier than **8.15am** please. There are three drop off gates:

St. Georges Road is a drop off zone only. No vehicles are permitted to enter the carpark other than people going to the Kindergarten or Church. There is a turning bay in front of the church which has a safe path for the students to walk down to school without going through the carpark. If parents wish to drop their child off or visit the teacher/office, they should park on St. Georges Road and walk their child into school.

Kelvinside Terrace: Drop children off at the top of Kelvinside Terrace on the corner of Arran St. No cars will be allowed down the drive. No parking is permitted on the right of way. Should parents wish to walk into school, they are to park on Kelvinside Terrace and walk their child into school.

Great North Road is one of the main entrances. Parents may drive into the right of way and park in the car park. There is a pedestrian entrance. Alternatively, children can be dropped at the top of the right of way and walk along the fence into the school. Parents dropping students must ensure that they see their child entering the school gate no earlier than **8.15am**. There are three drop off gates: St. Mary's Parish has very generously agreed to let us use their **second** car park in the *afternoons* to park and walk into school to collect your child/ren. This is

St. Mary's Parish has very generously agreed to let us use their **second** car park in the **afternoons** to park and walk into school to collect your child/ren. This is the entrance closest to White Cross. Please DO NOT use their main entrance which is reserved for the parents of St. Mary's School. This is **only for the afternoon** pick-ups where there is a need to park. We are NOT to use the St. Mary's car park in the morning.

Parking Guidelines

(p14 Parents' Information Booklet)

Reminder: parents please do not park in the church and kindergarten parking for morning and afternoon drop offs. It does not belong to us and they have asked that only school staff use the carpark and those who are disabled. You are welcome to use the turning bay in the front of the church for drop offs.

Please DO NOT use the main entrance of St. Mary's School—this is reserved for their parents; their second car park is ONLY to be used for afternoon pick-ups where there is a need to park.

Kelvinside Terrace is opened every morning and afternoon and Great North road entrance has some parking available there.

We really do appreciate your co-operation in this regard. Our relationships with the church, kindergarten and St. Mary's School (our neighbours) are very important to us and we would like to honour their requests.
