#### **Open afternoons:**

We have several times available for you to visit Nelson Intermediate School with your tamariki.

During our open afternoons, whānau and tamariki will receive a tour of the school, meet teachers, students and other staff. There will be an opportunity to find out more about the classroom curriculum, Māori medium opportunities, camp, sports, music programmes and clubs. There is also time for some Q & A.

Tours will be provided to whānau upon arrival to the school in groups of 15 - 20 in order to maintain social distancing; we encourage whānau and tamariki to wear a face mask. Upon arrival to NIS, please gather under the trees at the main entrance and we will show you around the kura. Tours will take approximately 45 minutes.

Whānau may also wish to come in with or without your tamariki outside of the above times and meet with a senior staff member. We welcome whānau in for these hui. An appointment just needs to be made with our office on 03 548 9572.

NIS staff will be visiting primary schools later in Term 2 in order to speak with students and hand out enrolment forms. We ask that enrolment forms are completed by early Term 3 so that we can start working on class lists and staffing.

In consultation with your child's primary school, we strive to ensure that each student starting at NIS has some familiar faces in their class.
