

The after-hours phone is connected to and answered by an afterhours registered nurse, who will assess your needs, offer advice, or arrange immediate assistance from the oncall doctor or rural nurse. (The triage nurse may take a few minutes to answer.)

Level 1

Thank you for your continued understanding during the changes with delivery of your health care.

If you have any respiratory, flu/cold like symptoms, sore throat, or cough, please still phone in advance to arrange an appointment, we will still triage in the normal way to continue to reduce the chance of infection. We will continue to update the community with any changes when they arise.

If you are unsure or have any questions, please ring the Health Centre to talk to the receptionist or the practice nurse.

Extended Consultations

Certain procedures at the Health Centre require extra Doctor and/or nurse time. If you wish to book an appointment for any of the following: Removal of Lesion, Skin Check, Fire Brigade Medical, Travel Consult, Insurance / Various Other Medicals, Men's/Women's Health Check, Driving Medical or if you are unsure if your appointment requires extra time - please ask the receptionist so she can book the time appropriately.

Laboratory results

When you have a blood test or cervical smear, the nurse will advise you that you will only be contacted if the results need to have some action taken (for example a repeat blood test or follow up with the Doctor).

If your results are insignificant you will not normally be notified. However, you are welcome to ring and speak to a practice nurse if you wish to discuss your results, usually after 2pm.

Winter Grazing – What you need to know

We have been working to developing our winter auditing programme to support improvement and understanding around winter management. This winter, winter grazing management will be included in the formal audit process.

All farms need to have a Winter Management Plan (WMP) before 1st May 2021.

This includes all farms grazing stock (regardless of stock type and class) behind a wire on forage crop between 1st May and 30th September.

NB: Dairy farms need a WMP for any crop grown on the dairy platform or used for transition purposes <u>and</u> on external grazing blocks.

We have arranged the following events to assist you to complete your WMP. These are open to all EC members:

Small Group Meetings – Completing your Winter Management Plan

Drop-in sessions to assist in completing your WMP. Sessions will commence every hour, on the hour. We encourage you to attend the session with your Farm Management Team, Stock and Landowner (if grazing on external blocks) to encourage alignment around practices, awareness and expectations.
