

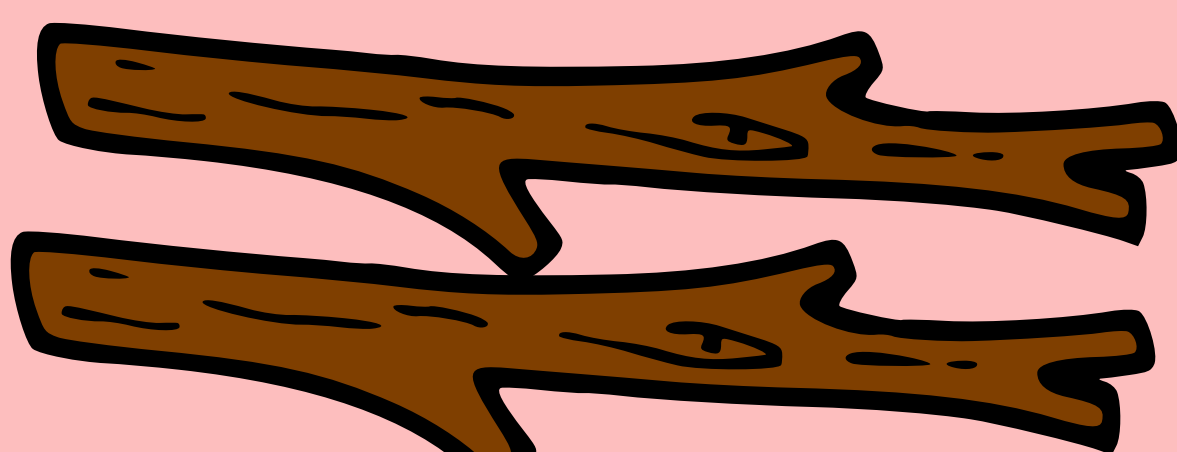
How The Sun Came To Be!

sticks.

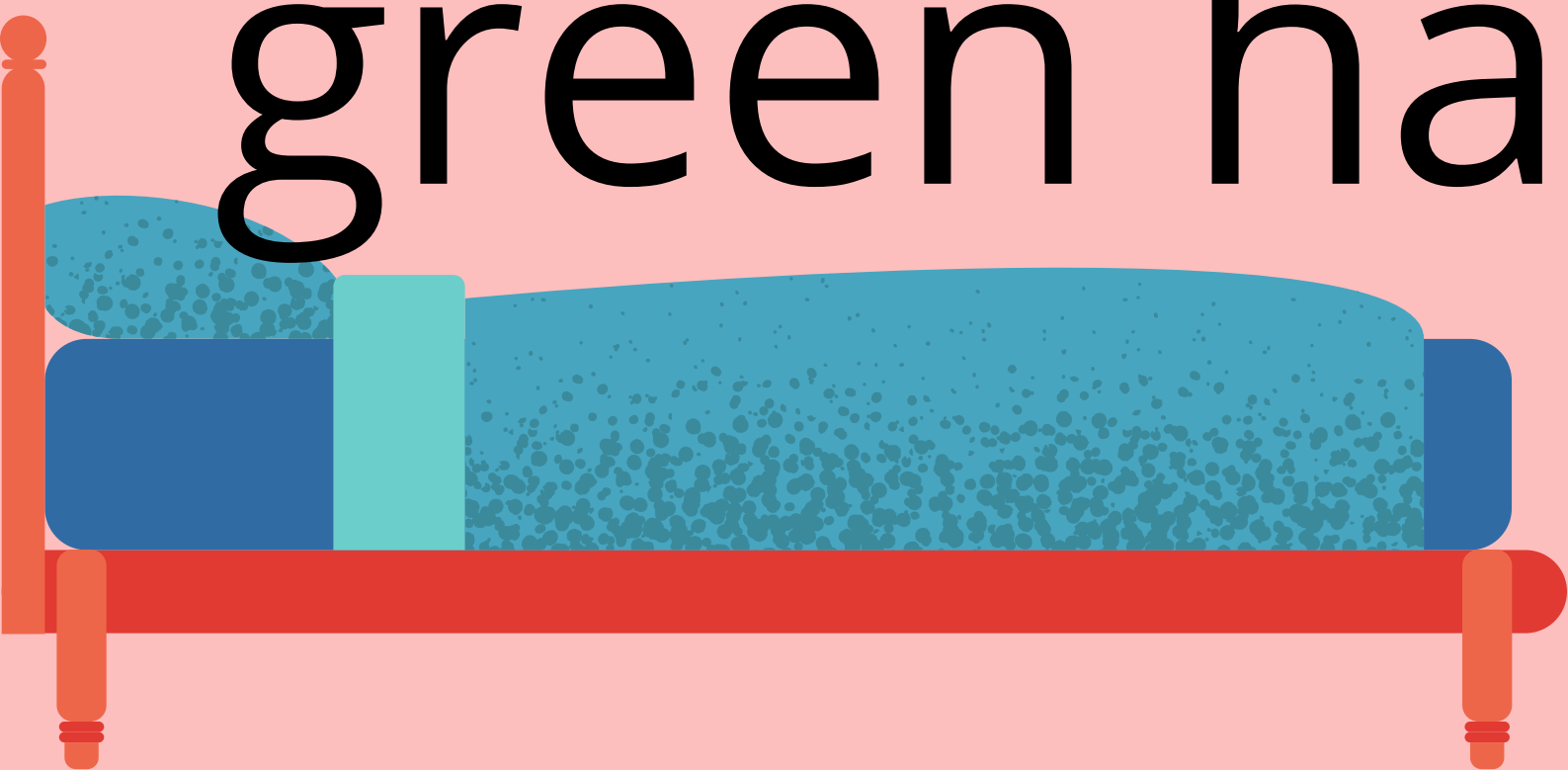


Everyone wanted

the country.



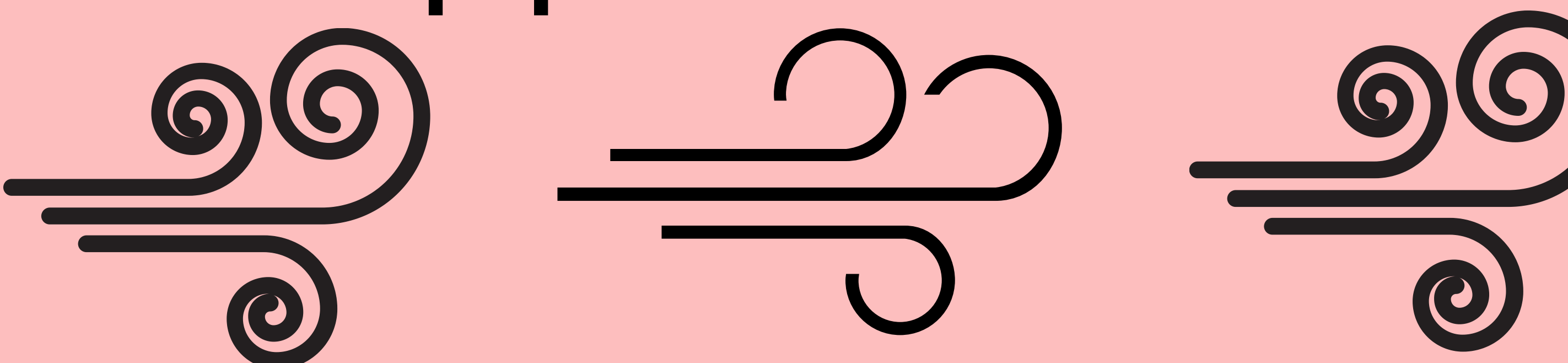
BANG! Olivia woke
