Expectations with Oxford Stars tasks:

- Your child will need to use a clearfile, folder or book to record their planning, evidence and reflections for each task. Alternatively, your child may like to complete their tasks on google slides or a google doc.
- Before you begin each task:
 - * Record the task name
 - * Planning: Include specific task details, eg *I am going to grow carrots and give them to the salvation Army food bank*
 - * Include when you will complete the task
 - * Any other important information
- Once you have completed the task you need to present evidence:
 - * This could be a photo, drawing or class presentation
- Reflection:
 - * What I learnt
 - * What I might do differently next time
 - * Family/friend comment

All planning and evidence needs to be kept together during the year.
