LET'S TALK ENTERPRISE

We hope you had a great holiday break and are looking forward to our final school term for 2023. There are a number of important dates (column to the right) that we encourage you to take note of as this Term promises to be an action-packed one.

In Term 4, our overarching concept focuses on Enterprise. We will be looking at the attributes of what makes an entrepreneur, being innovative, the technology product and design process, financial literacy that is involved with the creation, marketing and advertising of products and services, and developing an understanding of target audiences, data gathering and meeting market needs.

All of this learning will form the basis for our muchanticipated, and very popular, Toki Syndicate Bring and Buy Market Day taking place on 15 November.

Literacy

Our Reading and Writing this term will integrate the concept of Enterprise, including a variety of text types related to technology, innovation and entrepreneurship. We will also be unpacking relevant vocabulary through word studies and literacy tasks. This will include using language appropriate to the technology design process, following templates accordingly, and using persuasive language for marketing and advertising promotional materials.

For **Oral Language**, we have three tasks this term, each allowing students the chance to show their verbal creativity, expression and presenting skills. These tasks are included in their homework books.

To foster student agency, we will provide regular opportunities for students to reflect on their writing as well as to talk about their learning in a range of settings.

- Statistics with a focus on conducting investigations using the statistical enquiry cycle. This will include data gathering and sorting, analysing findings, displaying data, identifying patterns and trends and communicating these findings. This will be used in an authentic context with our Bring and Buy market day.
- Financial Literacy supported through the ASB GetWise programme to include the basics of understanding the concept of money and its values, goal setting and earning money.
- Time with a focus on reading analogue and digital clocks and solving problems involving time.
- Fractions and Proportions to enable students to find fractions of a set and use problem solving strategies to achieve this.
