
# Roncalli College Musical 2020 - Audition Pack

To sign up for auditions, please complete this <u>form</u> and you will be e-mailed a confirmed time on the e-mail you use to submit the form. You will need to wear comfortable clothing and shoes for dancing and moving around.

#### If you are auditioning for a general/chorus role, you will need to prepare:

- The song (We're all in this together reprise)
- The dance routine (All OR The first part only, with 19 seconds remaining)

#### If you are auditioning for a specific role, you will need to prepare:

- An excerpt choose from the selected characters to perform [N.B. The other lines will be read, or you can prepare to present them with someone else]
- A song
- A dance routine (the whole dance)

## **Commitments and Expectations**

This musical is an awesome opportunity for you to get involved in the Arts at Roncalli. In 2020, there will be a short and intensive rehearsal period for the whole cast in Term 2, which you will need to be available for. The main cast will be rehearsing throughout Term 1 in school time, along with some after school rehearsals.

In technical week (the week before the show) and production week (the week of the show), there will be some long rehearsals. You need to be able to commit to these times without complaint, otherwise do not audition.

Everyone is welcome to audition for this show, however we require a commitment from those involved and you will need to agree to and sign a contract (along with your parents/guardians) to show your commitment to this rehearsal and performance period.

You need to be committed, reliable, enthusiastic, willing to take feedback and work as a group.
