ROAD SAFETY CONCERNS IN WRIGHT STREET


The Dunedin City Council has been working with Kaikorai Primary School on a proposal to improve pedestrian safety on Wright Street during peak traffic times.

The proposed plan will allow children arriving and departing by car or on foot to have a safe and convenient crossing point to cross Wright Street.

We propose installing kerb extensions at the crossing point to improve visibility for pedestrians and motorists. The kerb extensions will also shorten the crossing distance for the children and allow some existing no stopping lines to be removed, allowing more on street parking.
