

Ensure 6 months after first booster.

The following people are recommended to receive a second booster as a **priority**.

People aged 65 years and over
Māori and Pacific peoples aged 50
years and over

Severely immunocompromised people

People aged 16 years who have a medical condition that increases the risk of severe breakthrough COVID-19 illness and or live with a disability with significant or complex health needs

In addition, a second booster is available for all people aged over **50** years


