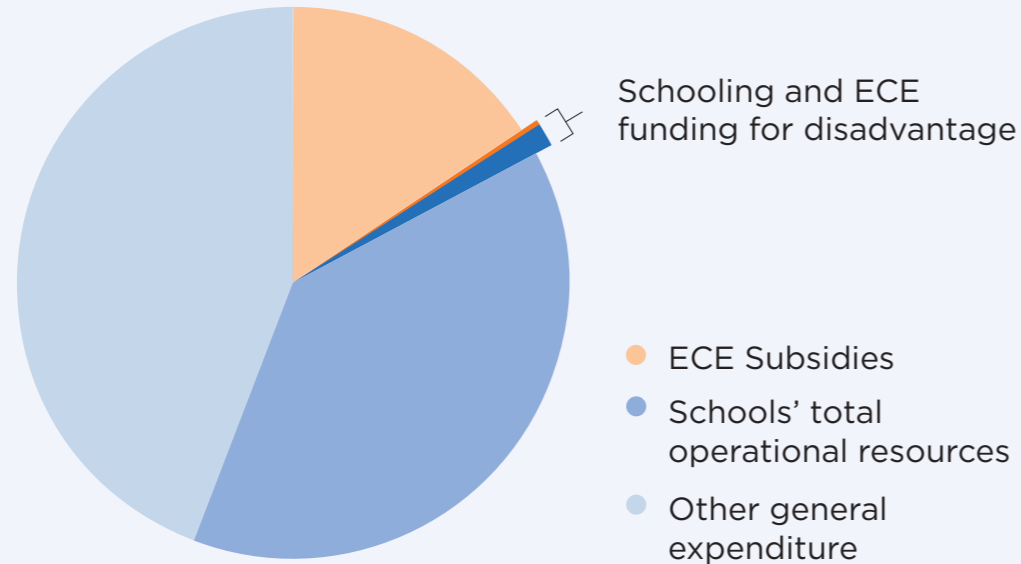

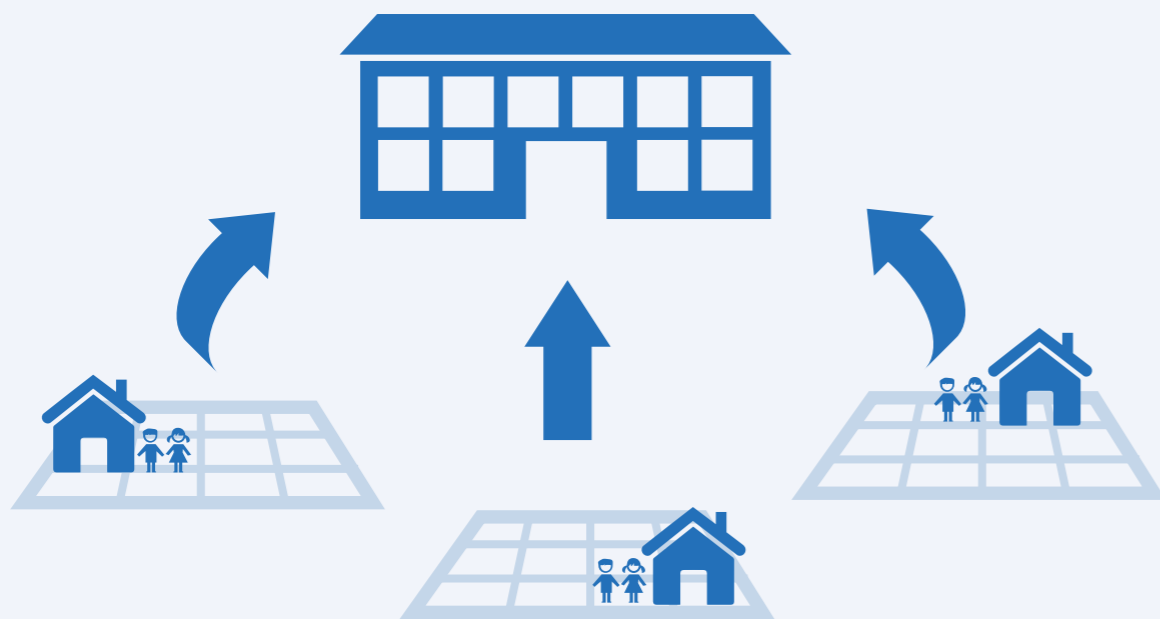

Features of future funding system for schools and early childhood education

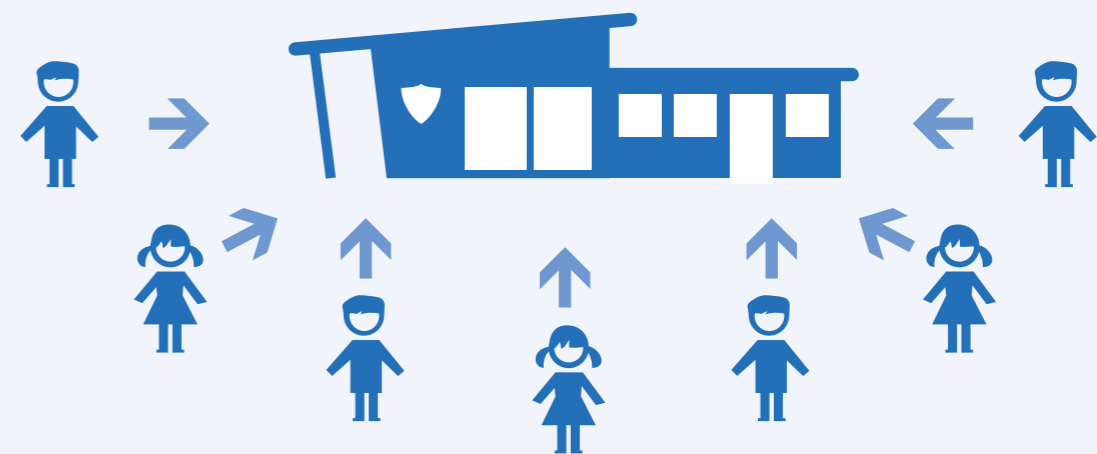
- ✓ strict privacy protections
- ✓ no reduction in funding as a result of replacement of decile system
- ✓ no branding/stigma of schools
- ✓ funding is better targeted to need
- ✓ schools choose how to spend money to support the progress and achievement of all learners

Current funding for disadvantage Neighbourhood focussed



Based on socio-economic and household data from the child's immediate neighbourhood

Future funding for disadvantage Child focussed



Based on characteristics of children in school, such as:

- » Time supported by benefits
- » Child, Youth and Family notification
- » Ethnicity
- » Parents average income
- » Mother's age at child birth
- » School transience
- » No. of children (Mother)
- » Country of birth
- » Youth Justice referral
- » Mother receives hardship payments
- » Father's offending and sentence history
