The North Asia CAPE is offering up to fifteen high school students of Chinese, Japanese, or Korean languages the opportunity to participate in a North Asia language and culture study tour.

Fully funded, this tour will be held mid-to-late September taking place domestically over four nights and five days in three locations - Dunedin, Wellington, and Auckland.

Participants will:

- Learn about the languages and cultures of China, Japan, and South Korea through immersive activities
- Gain an awareness and understanding of Aotearoa history as it relates to North Asia
- Improve their cross-cultural communication and awareness of global citizenship
- Grasp the wider significance of learning a North Asia language (Chinese, Japanese, Korean)

Eligibility:

- Students must be a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident
- Current language learners of Chinese, Japanese, or Korean in years 11-13 at a registered New Zealand high school
- Available for travel from 16 – 20 September
