

Covid Vaccine information

The Covid Vaccine will be free for everyone regardless of your residency or citizen status.

The vaccine teaches your immune system to recognise and fight off the virus, it does not contain the virus, it cannot alter your DNA, it cannot give you the disease.

All COVID-19 vaccines go through the same safety steps to meet robust standards, there have been no shortcuts.

Medsafe (NZ Medicines Safety Authority) have granted approval for the vaccines

The vaccine will be rolled out in groups we will advertise when and where you will be able to receive the vaccine.





WINTER FIRE SAFETY
