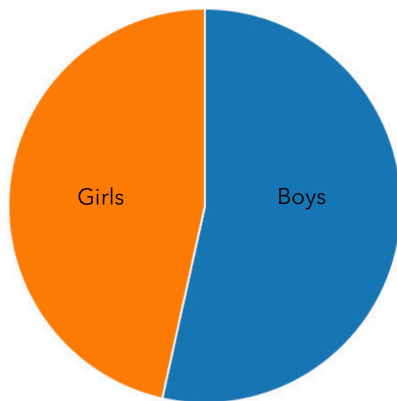

End of Year Data 2022

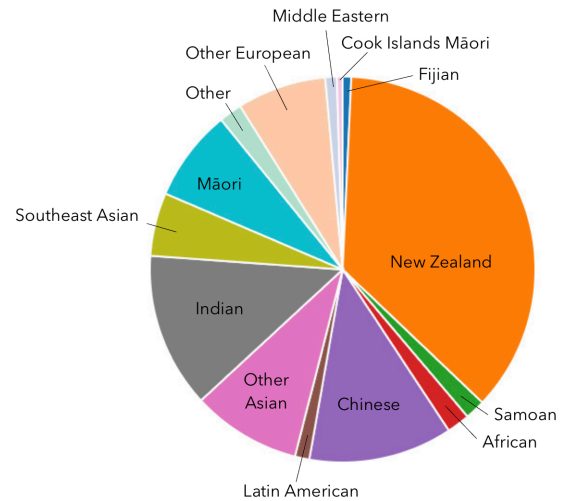


Gender Composition



399 students enrolled at the end of 2022
215 boys and 184 girls
76% of students are in **Year 0-4**

Reading

82% of students are achieving within or beyond expectation for their age and stage.

Writing

85% of students are achieving within or beyond expectation for their age and stage.

Maths

93% of students are achieving within or beyond expectation for their age and stage.

At Knights Stream School | Mingimingi Hautoa we consider reporting student achievement an important part of our teaching and learning process. Reporting on individual progress and achievement is carried out formally twice a year. We also collect and analyse school-wide assessment data. We use this information as the basis for changes to policies or programmes, changes to teaching practices, and to implement targeted interventions, as well as for reporting to the Board, whānau and the Ministry of Education.

Student data helps to inform the strategic direction of Knights Stream School | Mingimingi Hautoa. Assessment information may also be used to compare the relative achievement of different groups of students or to compare the achievement of our students against the New Zealand Curriculum levels. Progress and achievement is tracked using our student management system. Staff have a clear understanding of students progress and achievement, and their next steps for learning.
