Is your RAPID number correctly displayed?

Emergency services need to know where you live easily and quickly, RAPID numbers make this possible. Is yours correct?

RAPID numbers are vital for emergency services and are still used as the primary means of locating properties.

Hurunui District Council (HDC) has partnered with Fire and Emergency New Zealand to highlight the importance of a robust RAPID numbering system for the safety of you and your families.

Your RAPID number should be...

- Reflective and bold.
- Fixed on the gate post at the property entrance from the road.
- · Visible and clear of vegetation.

If you have multiple dwellings...

- · Each dwelling should have its own number displayed.
- And more than one dwelling is accessed off the same point on the road, an alpha suffix should be used for each dwelling and on-site directional signs may be required.



Rural Property Fire Safety

- Don't light fires if strong winds are expected
- Check old burn sites are completely out so that strong North Westerly winds don't cause a fire to flare up!
- IF old burn sites aren't fully out when fire restrictions start, you **need to apply for a permit** or put it out completely

Keep a close eye on the Fire Notice Board in front of the Fire Station


