

SPEED LIMITS BYLAW REVIEW – AMENDMENT 9

The Dunedin City Council has reviewed safe speed limits on roads throughout Dunedin. We took into account how the road is used, development in the area, national consistency and how the road feels to drivers.

The review recommended a range of changes. A number of the changes are for school areas and others relate to areas where land and road use have changed.

- Establish 40km/h variable speed limits around the five schools in the central city school area (Arthur Street School, Kavanagh College, Otago Boys' High School, Otago Girls' High School and St Joseph's Cathedral School).
- Establish 40km/h variable speed limits for another six school areas (Bayfield High School, East Taieri School, Fairfield School, George Street Normal School, Dunedin North Intermediate/Sacred Heart School Dunedin and Waitati School).
- Extend two existing school areas (Kaikorai Valley College and Wakari School).
- Establish a 40km/h permanent speed limit (Logan Park High School /Butts Road).
- Make changes for six additional road sections (Three Mile Hill Road, Main Road, Main South Road, Brighton Road, Gladstone Road North and Puddle Alley).
