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#### INTRODUCTION //

In 2021, Selwyn United began a strategy refresh in order to further develop the club's sustainability and capability.

Out of this came the need for a refreshed Football Development Plan based on the needs and wants of the membership within the club.

An engagement process was undertaken with members from throughout the club in the form of surveys, questionnaires, concept meetings and one on one interviews. From this, the aim was to develop a 'Concept' that the members were comfortable with and could relate to in the next phase of the development within the football club.

The findings were then consolidated to provide the Selwyn United Board with thorough detail around the competencies needed to meet the demands of the club now but also into the future in order to future proof the club for growth and retention.



The Selwyn United Football Development Plan

– 'Lead The Way' is aimed at developing a club, that across the board, can lead the way for football both locally and nationally.

The findings across the board were very clear and give Selwyn United Football Club an exciting opportunity to further develop over the coming years.

The first finding was a real need for the clubs Purpose or 'Why' to be something that all members can be a part of. On the back of Selwyn United's Strategic Refresh 'Enriching the lives of those in our community through the game of football' became the club's vision and should become a powerful tool to developing an environment that allows all members to have the best possible experience regardless of their motivation to be involved in the game.



The second finding was a need to be uniquely member focused and to develop a community where we celebrate our people within our club that add to what we do. There is a strong focus throughout the 'Lead The Way' document on how we support, develop and celebrate our members.

The final major finding was in relation to planning and processes for our members. It was agreed across the board that the club is now an entity that operates year-round to provide an environment for all players to play the game. Throughout the 'Lead The Way' document there is a consistent messaging around the need to put clear planning and processes around the work we do as a club, and this will be a clear driver in the coming years.

We would like to thank all members for their engagement throughout the process and we are very proud to be able to bring 'Lead The Way' to you, the Selwyn United family.





All coaches are also welcome to Skill Centre, Talent Centre and First Team Sessions to see the club's most qualified coaches in action!


#### PHILOSOPHY

All of this is focused on Long Term Player Development and Participation. We want lifelong participants within the game of football at Selwyn United!

The formations suggested are formations that we deem to be the best for player development at those age groups and give the players the best possible opportunity of development.

Players should be given the opportunity to play in a variety of positions throughout their pathway for them to choose a position they most enjoy! As players move closer to senior football, they will begin to focus on a Primary & Secondary position.

All of this will help to develop well rounded, creative and fun focused players who will stay in the game for a lifetime!

# OUR IDENTITY //

Selwyn United First Team Members have a duty to represent the club on and off the field in a manner that represents the identity of the club and allows them to be role models. We will support all of the club to carry this identity with them on and off the field also!

#### PLAYER IDENTITY

At Selwyn United, we identify, scout and develop differently to most football clubs. We believe the defining factor in a player's development is a commitment to the game and a focus on wanting to get better.

We understand that all players have different motivations for playing the game and we work hard to cater for all.

At Junior grades, we limit our selection process as much as we can to ensure players get the right environment for them. Skill Centres are open for players of all abilities and motivations and provide access to the best junior coaches in the region!

At Youth Grades, players that commit to our full-time program receive an abundance of support to develop at the right level for the individual. Players outside of this still receive support relative to their level of commitment. The club works hard to keep a close eye on all youth teams to ensure nobody is missed.

If players commit to wanting to get better over a prolonged period of time, Selwyn United commit to you as an individual!

### PLAYING IDENTITY

'At Selwyn United, we believe in a forward thinking, brave and creative brand of football.

We defend with an emphasis on winning the ball through a ball orientated defensive system, a focus on individual and team accountability for roles & responsibilities.

In transitions, we are dominant with the first thought being about getting on the front foot as soon as possible.

What makes us unique is our energy to 'Lead The Way' through challenging the norm and a constant focus on getting better each and every day.'



## OUR DEVELOPMENT //

Selwyn United breaks down Football Development in to 4 key areas:

- The Foundation Phase (4-8yrs old)
- The Skill Development Phase (9-12yrs old)
- The Youth Development Phase (13-19yrs old)
- 4. The Performance Phase (20+ yrs old)

Here, we break down the main objectives of what we try to achieve in each phase!



It does exactly what it says on the tin!

In the discovery phase, we aim to allow children to fall in love with the beautiful game. We encourage the whole environment at this age to be exciting, enjoyably and stimulating!

Training and games involve lots of movement, plenty of ball contacts and loads of encouragement with limited coaching!

#### SKILL DEVELOPMENT

During the Skill Development Phase, players are beginning to really adapt to motor learning skills. This means that this time truly is the 'Golden Age' of motor learning.

This phase is the optimal time to focus on core skills that will allow for long term participation in the game. Players are given the option to train 1,2 or 3 times a week plus a game and all focus should be on learning football skills within the context of the game.

Selwyn United also champions Futsal as an incredibly powerful tool in Skill Development and recommends Futsal Programs as well as our local leagues as an excellent option for this phase!

At Selwyn United we believe in this simple format for a Skill Development Session:

1 Ball: 1 Player


1 Ball: 2 Players (e.g. 1v1)

1 Ball: 5/6 Players (e.g. 3v3 or 4v2)

1 Ball : 10/12 Players (e.g. 5v5)









# OUR DEVELOPMENT //

## YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

In the Youth Development Phase, we tend to see players' motivation for playing the game of football become more and more stretched due to the abundance of opportunities available to them.

Due to this, Selwyn United has an abundance of opportunities for players wanting to play the game varying from a full-time program through to a single session program as to make sure we cater for all motivations and abilities.

In this phase we concentrate on how to work in units and teams towards a common strategy and goal.

Coaches across the club are given the opportunity in both Formal & Informal sessions to develop their understanding on how to best work with Youth players and develop their game! There are also session plans available for all coaches!

In this phase, we suggest the following Session Format:

Unnopposed Technical Practice (e.g. Passing Practice)

Small Opposed Practice (e.g. Rondo)

Large Opposed Practice (e.g. Positioning Game)

Conditioned Game (e.g. 7v7 Game)



## PERFORMANCE PHASE

The purpose of the Performance Phase is to create the highest level of team performance on every occasion. The intensity & level of training from this point increases dramatically to ensure players are equipped to be able to play at the highest possible level regionally, nationally and internationally.

A key focus becomes team tactics and is done by creating sessions that are focused on solving problems and pushing players on a daily basis.

Players entering and progressing through this phase need to be able to be pro-active in themselves to drive performance. This may include sacrifices in their personal life to play at this level, lifestyle changes to incorporate conditioning elements and a true commitment to the game in terms of understanding and implementation of tactics

Selwyn United is aiming to do something we believe is truly special. We are aiming to 'Enrich the lives of those in our community through the game of football'.

'Lead The Way' is a document put together to tell the story of how we aim to do this. We truly believe we can affect every one of our members in a positive way.
