

#### **Prescriptions**

To avoid running out of your medications, please make sure you check when they are next due and allow at least **two weeks** prior to that date, so that you have enough time to arrange an appointment to see the doctor and avoid disappointment.

When the surgery is very busy it may not be possible to get an appointment at short notice, and if an urgent prescription is required, a short prescription of **one week** may be given in lieu of an appointment with the doctor, these will incur an additional fee. All patients must be seen by the doctor every three months for repeat medication, unless otherwise indicated and documented by a doctor in the patients notes.



#### **CULVERDEN VOLUNTEER FIRE BRIGADE**

#### **Rural Property Fire Safety**

- Don't light fires if strong winds are expected



- Check old burn sites are completely out so that strong North Westerly winds don't cause a fire to flare up!
- IF old burn sites aren't fully out when fire restrictions start, you need to apply for a
  permit or put it out completely

Keep a close eye on the Fire Notice Board in front of the Fire Station
