

What is Skinny Jump?

Skinny Jump is a flexible prepaid wireless broadband service. Ciena and the Spark Foundation have teamed up to sponsor Jump for selected homes. This means your family could be eligible for free broadband for the entire school year.

What is the Ciena Jump for Students Fund?

The Ciena Jump for Students Fund is intended for students who don't have a current connection at home. Ciena Jump helps students to get a broadband connection to study and learn.

How do I sign up?

Fill in the form on the reverse and return it to your school leader. If you're eligible, your school leader will give you a modem. They will then talk you through the set up process and what you can do to stay safe online and manage your data.

Already have Jump?

You can still be a part of the Ciena Jump for Students Fund. This means you will no longer need to pay for Jump. Talk to your school leader about switching your plan.

*You will get free broadband until the end of December 2021. After this you will have the option to sign up to standard Skinny Jump which is \$5 for 30GB.

Terms & Conditions of Ciena Jump for Students Fund

Skinny's standard terms and conditions apply (www.skinny.co.nz/skinny-terms), as well as the additional terms below:

- If your modem is damaged, lost or malfunctioning please contact your school immediately.
- Your Skinny Jump modem and data are fully sponsored by the Ciena Schools Fund. We will provide reporting on modem uptake and regular usage to your school.
- Skinny Jump (Jump) is for homes who currently do not have broadband and cost is a significant barrier and are most at risk of digital exclusion (as identified in the Government's digital inclusion blueprint). Eligibility for Jump is at the sole discretion of Skinny (or our agents).
- Skinny reserves the right to rescind your eligibility for Skinny Jump if
 we believe, acting reasonably, that your use of the service does not
 fit with the intended purpose of Jump. We will give you one month's
 notice if we are going to rescind your eligibility for Jump.

Modem

- You will be provided with a Modem to connect to Skinny Jump.
 The Modem remains the property of Skinny and you must return it (including all the parts and information provided) if you leave Skinny Jump. On termination, we will advise you how to return the Modem.
- You may not sell, lease, dispose of, lend or otherwise part with possession of, or modify the Modem in any way.
- The Modem contains a SIM card. You may not use this SIM card in any other device. The SIM card remains the property of Skinny and must be returned with the Modem.

Broadband Data

- You will receive 150GB to use each month for the school year. Your 150GB will automatically be loaded on the 1st of each month (Feb 2021 - Dec 2021). Any unused data expires at the end of each calendar month and does not rollover.
- Once you've used all of your 150GB per month your data will come to a complete stop.
- We strongly recommend you use the broadband data usage meter to monitor your broadband data use. You can access the broadband data usage meter when you login to your Skinny account at skinny.co.nz.

Data Sharing

- Skinny will collect information (and will pass this on to your school)
 about whether you have connected your modem, how much data
 is being used (but not what you are using it for), if your modem is
 unused for a long period, and troubleshooting for returns.
- Skinny will also report at a high level to your school, that does not identify you. For example, this high-level reporting might say, "70% of students have connected their modems and 60% are using more than XGB each month."
