Experience a unique guided 4WD tour behind the gates of private High Country stations in the Windwhistle and Lake Coleridge area. Witness breathtaking scenery, learn about High Country life and enjoy a gourmet picnic lunch.

Details:

- Starting at Quartz Hill Station 9.30am (registration from 8.45am) and will end near Lake Coleridge approximately 4.30pm.
 - Morning tea, gourmet picnic lunch and afternoon tea catered by the Social Platter Co.
 - There will be several toilet stops along the track.
 - Registration pack with information about the stations you will cross and the area will be provided on the day.
 - There will be designated stops along the tracks where speakers will talk about farming, land formation, history and more.
 - This is a self-drive 4WD tour on off-road formed farm tracks.
 - A high-clearance 4WD is necessary for the tour. Some of the track is not suitable for smaller 4WD's such as Honda HRV, Nissan Xtrail, Forrester's etc. Vehicles need low range sufficient to cope with steeper climbs on some of the track. No low profile tyres. Vehicles need to be weed free and clean.
 - Limited to just 60 vehicles.
 - A limited number of Chauffeured seats are available in designated vehicles with local guides.

- Self-Drive - \$500.00 per vehicle limited to 5 people (including driver, adults or children) per vehicle.
 - Chauffeured - \$170.00 per person.
 - Register and pay online.

 - A postponement date has been set for Sunday 26th March 2023, there will be no refunds if the event is postponed and you cannot make it.
 - Numbers are limited, it will be first basis first served so don't delay booking.
