The swimming pool is getting ready to open! A special thanks to Tony Stanton and Eve Reihana for their work. There was plenty of sediment left in the pool from last year's sand blasting and this caused issues for our filter last summer. Once the pool is cleaned out, we can begin to

fill it. Fingers crossed we will get more stable weather for swimming shortly as while we have had some hot days, we've certainly had some cold ones too!

We would like to acknowledge our sponsors FIL. They supply our chlorine, and their generous donation saves us over \$5000 a year. Once we get the pool filled, their chlorine will be used to keep the water blue and sparkly.

Culverden Amateur Swim Club is the community arm of the pool. In conjunction with Amuri Area School, we run the pool over the summer months and are responsible for one third of the costs, while school pays two thirds. Our costs last summer came to \$18,130.00; pools are not cheap to run! But included in that was a repaint and a new chlorine pump. We are hoping to sell plenty of keys this summer to help cover this year's costs.

Key sales keep the pool open to the community so please purchase a key if you are a regular user of the pool. A list of paid key holders will be displayed in the shed window and updated regularly. The casual swim key will no longer be available from the Four Square. Sadly, too many people have abused this privilege last summer and it makes a mockery of our key holders who are paying to have a key. A casual swimmer will be able to enter the pool if there are key holders there. We request a gold coin donation per swimmer when you enter the pool. Again, without these small donations, the swim club struggles to stay afloat financially. Please respect our newly painted pool and be responsible pool users.


