Thank you for your continued understanding during the changes with delivery of your healthcare. Amuri Health will be open, but patients will need to phone in advance to arrange their appointment time. We can still offer and encourage telephone consults where possible. There are to be no walk-ins please. Patients are required to phone upon their arrival at their appointment time so we can continue to minimise congestion in the waiting areas. We request patients are wearing a mask upon their arrival and follow practice guidelines. Where possible only the person who has the appointment should attend the Health Centre. Anyone who has respiratory, flu/cold like symptoms, sore throat, or cough will continue to be triaged first and seen via the rear of the building.




