### Hello to all our Parents / Caregivers

Here we are heading towards the end of the year and all the busyness that goes along with it. In Canterbury, we have been very fortunate to continue with far fewer impacts of the pandemic than those living in the North Island. While we have needed to make changes to how we work at school, for the most part we have been able to continue as normal.

End of year events need to be organised in advance so we have continued to plan for children only. Our final senior assembly will be live streamed by a professional videographer on Thursday, 16 December in the afternoon. We will provide all the details closer to the date.

As the end of the year approaches events and breakups start to change our daily routines, and along with lighter evenings children's sleep times seem to vary. We are noticing many tired children and want to encourage regular sleeping habits over these last few weeks. Tired children, as we all know, find it more difficult to regulate themselves and stay focussed on their learning.

### Pizza with the Principal

During the year around 200 children have enjoyed having a pizza lunch with the Principal as part of our Awhi acknowledgement framework. Once children have earned 300 Awhis at each Bronze, Silver, Gold and Platinum level they are able to have this lunchtime treat. We are always impressed with the children's manners at these times and love seeing them enjoy the reward for having demonstrated our school values.





## Swimming Pool

The pool is owned by the Christchurch City Council, and leased to Belfast School. As the leaseholders we are required to implement the health and safety requirements recommended by the Council. This means for the 2021-2022 season the pool will operate as a **Vaccine Mandated facility**. This means adults hiring a pool key will need to show proof of vaccination (certificate or My Pass) when collecting the key. The pool hire agreement will require key holders to confirm that all users over 16 years of age will be vaccinated. If a pool user is identified as a positive COVID-19 case the pool will need to be closed for cleaning at the Board's expense. The cost for hiring a pool key for this season is \$100.00 with a \$20.00 deposit, a total of \$120.00. We will advertise when the pool is ready for use and keys can be purchased from the office.

## Planning for 2022

Planning is underway, with direction from the Ministry of Education and Public Health, on the changes expected as the country moves away from the elimination strategy for COVID-19. The government plan for the traffic light system will be announced on Monday afternoon. The Ministry of Education has advised that schools can retain their existing COVID-19 settings until the end of the 2021 calendar year while they prepare to implement the Framework Practices from 1 January 2022.

We will continue with our current practices through to the end of the year while we get clarity around safe practices for our students and staff. Our focus remains on reducing risk of transmission, accurate contact tracing, good hygiene and vaccinations. We will ensure you know about these before school starts in the new year.
