Our online classes are scheduled to run in 'real time' once a week through Zoom web conferencing and supported by our own WeLearn social networking site that learners can access anytime.

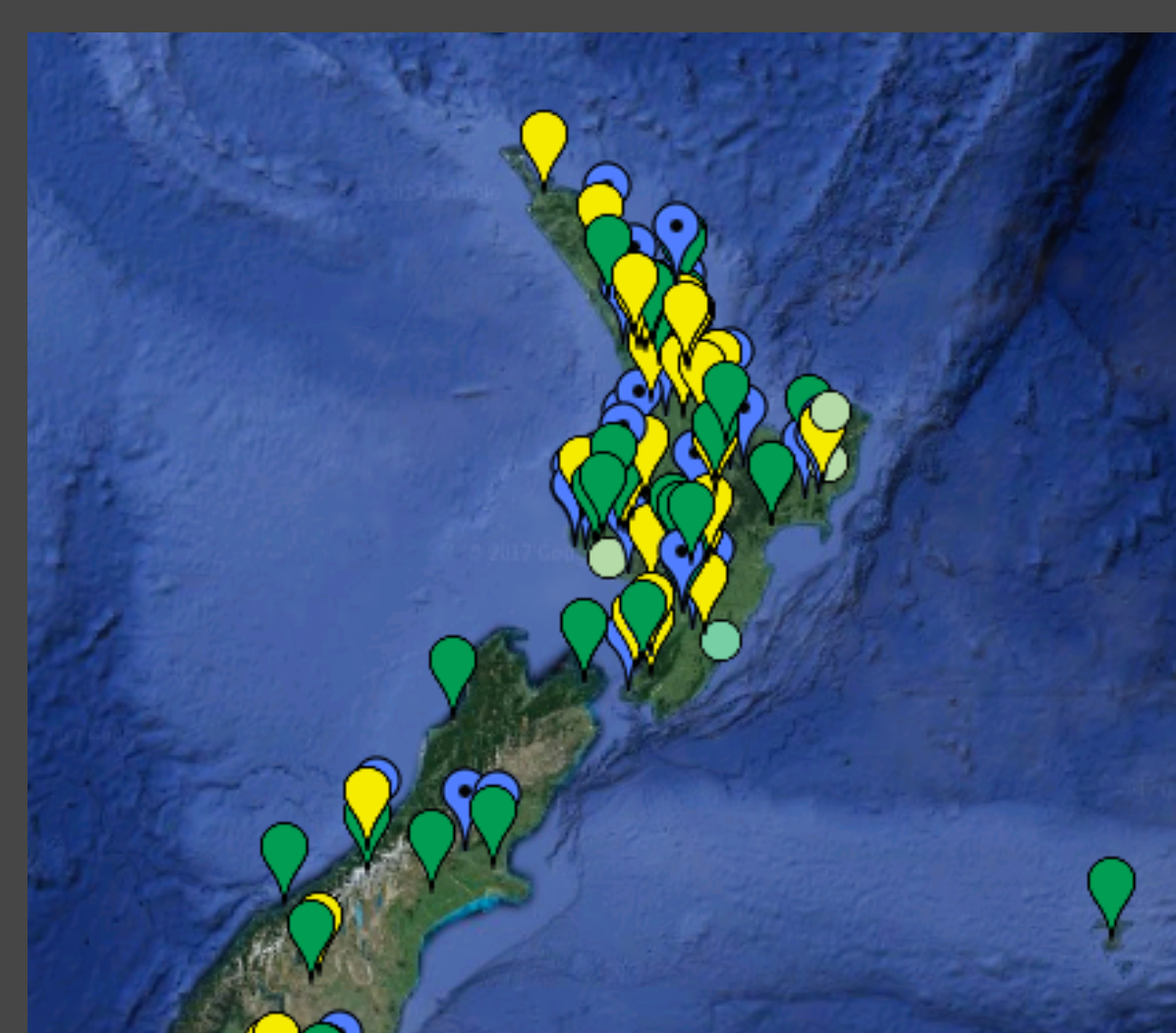
