## ISLEWORTH SCHOOL

Isleworth School, established in 1962, is situated in the north-west area of Christchurch in the suburb of Bishopdale. In the early 1970's the roll was in excess of 1000, our roll today is around 310 with a maximum capacity of 350 students. The present population is diverse with many different nationalities represented. Isleworth School is a decile 5 school.

The school is made up of 3 blocks of permanent materials, one large prefab block, a stand alone hall, a repurposed dental clinic, several sealed play areas and a swimming pool complex. We are currently on track for our Ministry Refurbishment. This has begun with the removal of our old Learning Centre to make way for a newly built flat, flexible, multi-purpose space.

We are part of the Waimairi-iri Kahui Ako that is made up of a large group of local schools: Allenvale School, Breens Intermediate, Burnside High School, Burnside Primary School, Christ the King Catholic School, Cobham Intermediate, Fendalton School, Harewood School, Isleworth School, St Patrick's Catholic School Bryndwr, Te Ara Maurea Roydvale School, Wairakei School and a number of local preschools.

### Vision

The needs of the pupils are paramount, this was reflected in community surveys of both students, whanau, staff and stakeholders. In 2020 we developed the school's new vision:

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The vision is underpinned by 3 key strategic dimensions:

1. Whānaungatanga (Relationships)
2. Hauora (Well-being)
3. Creative, Dynamic Learning Environment

Our priority for 2021 is continuing to focus on our people and quality teaching and learning while undergoing refurbishment.
