We have great pleasure in inviting you to our College Ball in 2023. We extend this invitation to your son, his partner and yourselves to a night full of celebration. The theme this year is 'Hollywood". The entertainment will by a DJ and the Band 'Mama Rock'. This event will occur on the **16th September 2023** at the **Addington Raceway.**

Tickets

The ticket pricing will be \$90 for a single ticket, \$170 for a double and \$300 for family (this includes 2 x parents, your son and his partner). Tickets can be purchased now and will be available to be purchased until the **8th September 2023**. You can pay for tickets via internet banking. The number is: 03 0802 0910911 00. Please put your son's name and 'ball' in reference column. You will still be required to hand your form in to Jackie Redmond. Any other cash or eftpos payments must be given to Jackie Redmond, College Bursar.

Time and Arrival

The Ball will run from 7.00-11:30pm. Students, partners and parents will be required to arrive from 7.00 to 8.00pm. Upon arrival the Principal and several guests will greet everyone arriving at the Ball. Finger food will be provided and this is included in the cost of the tickets.

Photographer

We are booking a photographer for the evening, who will make the photos available to the students, we also have a photo booth.

Alcohol

Alcohol will be served on the night. Addington Raceway has outlined clear regulations that we will be required to follow. All students and partners who are over the age of 18 will be given black wristbands allowing them to drink alcohol. All students of St Thomas' who have a parent or legal guardian present on the night and are under 18 will be given a green wristband. Parents will still be required to purchase the alcohol for these students. All partners who are under 18 will not be able to drink at this function. We will need proof of identification on the night of the event if a partner is 18 and wishing to drink. Students under 18 who do not have parents present on the night will not be able to drink. A cash bar will be open on the night. No alcohol can be brought into the venue. Right of admittance is reserved and those who are not appropriately dressed or are intoxicated will not be admitted.

Security

On the night there will be a strong teacher presence. The Deans will all be attending along with Senior Management. Addington Raceway is providing two security staff at the door also throughout the night, as a support for the staff and to make sure the night is going well. Due to this event being a formal event for the senior school only, all partners will be required to be **at least 16 years of age** on the night.

Smoking

This is a **non-smoking event**. Smoking is also prohibited outside of the venue.

Transport

When the night comes to a close, we advise for your family to take caution driving. We encourage that you have prior plans to get home, either through a sober driver or one of the taxis that will be at the door. Several taxis will be waiting at the end of the night. If you wish to leave your vehicles there overnight, they must be picked up by 10.00am the following morning.
