Taite Mone/Maundy Thursday: Serving one another.

Jesus said: "If I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you ought to wash one another's feet."

—John 13:14

We sometimes find it is easier to serve than to be served. Jesus calls us to do both. Often disabled people are seen as needing to be served rather than being able to serve. As with all disciples of Jesus, disabled people are commanded to do both: serve and be served.

Think about the ways in which you serve and are served as part of the Body of Christ. If you are finding you are moving from being someone who serves to someone who is being served, ask God to be with you as you go through this transition.
