## The Deans Scholarship

The Deans Scholarship is the premier award made by the School and recognises Robert Deans, a Senior Monitor of the School and one of the most distinguished leaders in character and athletics. It was founded in 1908, and quoting from the School magazine of 1910 –

*“A sum of two hundred and twenty pounds has been raised, and when the cost of the tablet and medal had been defrayed, the balance would be put out at interest for the purpose of founding a Scholarship for the boys, who in the opinion of the Trustees, displayed qualities such as they honoured in the memory of the late Robert Deans.”*

*“The Memorial was not so much to Deans the famous athlete and footballer, as to Deans the fine true man who stood as an ideal for even the youngest boy to copy.”*

*“No matter what way things went, Deans always stood for the right. He exerted that influence whilst at school; he exerted it after he left.*

## George Sanders Award

George Herbert Sanders was an Old Boy of Christchurch Boys’ High School.

Much of George’s life was defined by war. He was a navigator in a Lancaster Bomber during the Second World War. His plane was shot down over France in 1944 and though George successfully bailed out his pilot and rear gunner were killed, and this experience deeply touched George. Another touching moment for George was the Masters of Christchurch Boys’ High School greeting Old Boy Service Men on their return to New Zealand at Lyttleton and carrying their bags off the ship.

After the war he studied medicine at Otago University and then worked as a General Practitioner in Auckland and Christchurch. George attributed his career to his Boys’ High Education.

The George Sanders Award is presented to a student who does not receive any other major award. It recognises a student of Christchurch Boys’ High School who in the opinion of the Award Committee best reflects the ideals and attributes of modern and global leadership for the service of others.

## Centennial Award

The Centennial Award, in the name of the Christchurch Boys’ High School Old Boys’ Association, recognises the founding of the Association in 1912.

The award is to a Year 13 student who has, during this past year performed to, or contributed at an exceptional level nationally and/or internationally. In the pursuit of his achievements the recipient has enhanced the name of Christchurch Boys’ High School through his manner and his commitment, and he has provided a fine role model for all other students of the school.

## Jake Bailey Award

This award is to be presented to a student who has faced up to adversity or has shown strength of character throughout his years at CBHS. It was presented to the school by Jake Bailey – Senior Monitor in 2015.
