#### HOW OLD DOES MY CHILD HAVE TO BE?

The programme begins 5.00pm Sunday the 21st February at St Patrick's Church Parish Centre and goes through the first and second school terms, concluding with First Holy Communion on Sunday 13th June 2021.

The whole point of the programme is to prepare your child to receive Jesus in First Holy Communion. So the first and most important thing is...

Look at **your** commitment to coming to Mass. You can't say First Communion is important to your child if you're not attending Mass regularly.

As your child's first teacher in the ways of faith you need to teach by example.

#### PARENT MEETINGS

There are four parent meetings that are held on a Sunday evening at 5.00pm in St Patrick's Church Parish Centre.

The parent meetings are to prepare you to guide your child through each of the twelve lessons.

The programme is fairly self explanatory; there is a parents' guide and children's worksheets for each lesson. The parent meetings are also important for explaining what is not in the programme and for sharing teaching techniques and ideas that my be helpful. If there is no one at home to look after your children, you are welcome to bring them with you. They may bring quiet activities and be in the meeting room.
