Uniform Items	Navy Polo with logo Navy Fleece with logo Soft Shell Jacket – Black with logo Navy jersey with logo	<p><i>Appropriate to the school setting means it must not be offensive. 	YEARS 3-13	
Sports	Black PE top with logo Black PE short Black PE pants	
Jewellery	Appropriate jewellery, taonga & pounamu provided that they meet the school expectations (see below) and do not interfere with learning or safety. Piercings cannot be joined by chains and stretchers & long studs are not permitted. Other body piercings must not be visible including tongue piercings.	
Hair	Hair colourings must be suitable for a positive school environment and length/style must not interfere with learning or safety. Long hair may need to be tied back in some settings.	
Other	Make-up, nail length & colour must be appropriate to the school setting and must not interfere with learning or safety to self or others.
