

Urgent Prescription Charges

Please note that there will be a new fee of \$25 applied to any urgent telephone prescription requests that are required within 24hours. These requests often impact greatly to the doctors and nurse workload on already busy days. Amuri Health encourages patients to monitor their medications and allow plenty of time to arrange an appointment and or request repeat prescriptions to avoid disappointment or high costs. This new fee will be introduced at the end of September, the charge applies to all adults and children irrespective of age.





- Check Expiry date of smoke alarm
- Check smoke alarm is clean and free of dust, cobwebs etc
