## **Rules:**

- TEAMS CAN HAVE ANY NUMBER OF RIDERS, WITH ONE TEAM ONLY PER PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL. SCHOOLS WHO HAVE PRIMARY AND SECONDARY STUDENTS MAY ENTER ONE IN EACH DIVISION.
- **Secondary** 4 scores are required to make a team score the top live score from 3 different heights plus the next best score.
- **Primary** 4 scores are required to make a team score the top live score from 3 different heights plus the next best score.
- Scoring:
  - Dressage scores >55% 5 Points, sores <55% 2 points
  - Jumping 5 points for each clear jumping round, 2 points for live rounds

 Games – 1 point for each completed game, placings across the 3 games combined

Bonus points are added to the above score for place getters in each phase.  $1^{st}$ = 6pts.  $2^{nd}$ = 5pts.  $3^{rd}$  = 4pts.  $4^{th}$  = 3pts.

Riders may choose not to compete in the Jumping or Games and have no points given for that phase.

- Schools with less than 4 riders will be placed into a composite team by the organising committee.
- Teams to provide 2 helpers (named with contact details) for the day. Please ensure parents have been informed if they are named as a helper.
- Riders do not have to be a Pony Club member but will be required to fill out a NZPCA Casual Membership Form.
- School colours to be worn by each team.
- Alan Barker Interschool **Shield** for the winning Secondary School. **Trophy** for winning Primary School and a **Turnout Trophy** will be presented.
- Overnight horse accommodation at Otago Taieri A & P Showgrounds please let the event secretary know if you need yards or stables.
- Covid restrictions will apply.
