



## Covid Protection Framework for KSS in RED Setting



### Phase Two (active transmission in the Canterbury region)

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

There is a surge in active cases in the Canterbury region and the School is now moving into **Phase Two** of our safety plan effective from tomorrow.

The following protocols will be in place to protect the children and staff from contracting the virus.

Our planning will take into account those children who will have to be at school all of the time due to your work commitments.

### **Limiting Visitors Onsite**

- No parents/whānau are to come onto the school grounds. Where practical all visits to our site will be arranged in advance via the Tari (Office)
- Face to face meetings with staff and visitors will only take place in exceptional circumstances
- Communication with staff will be via phone, email or Zoom
- Kapa haka and music lessons will not take place
- School events and camps will take place providing we can meet safety requirements. We will try to reschedule these for later in the year if possible
- Sushi and Subway lunches will not be operating at the phase two setting.

### **Reduced Groupings**

The school will now be operating in **three separate schools**, each with their own play area. Staff will not be crossing over during the school day.

- Each block has their own entry point. Those with siblings will enter at the gate allocated to the youngest sibling. Please make a meeting point (e.g the corner of the playground in Neil Graham Park) for your child/ren to avoid congestion near the gate areas
- One member from each team will be greeting children in the morning
- Teachers will be helping children connect with you at the pick-up time.

<b>Ōpouira</b> – Matua Gregory Team Leader	Year 2-3	Side gate by Neil Graham Park
<b>Ōtūmatua</b> – Matua Craig Team Leader	Year 4-8	Killarney Avenue gate
