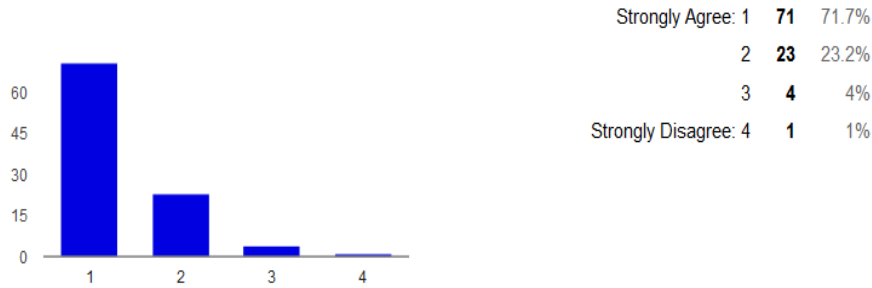

The Kaikorai Primary School's values of Kind, Aspiring, Independent and Keen are appropriate for your child



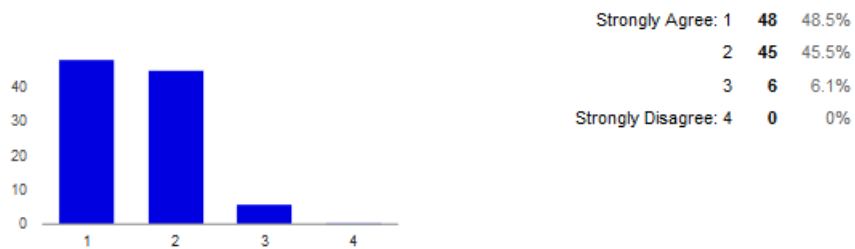
Having the school's values more explicit has helped your child?



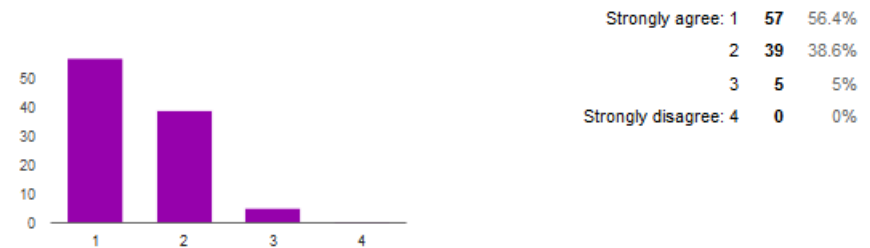
Your child knows and understands the schools values?



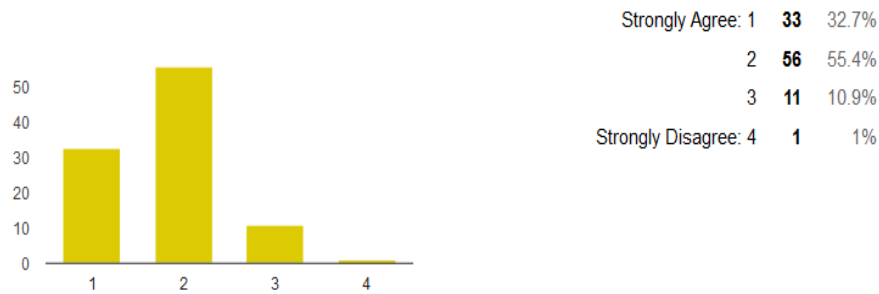
Kaikorai provides interesting learning, sporting and cultural opportunities for all children



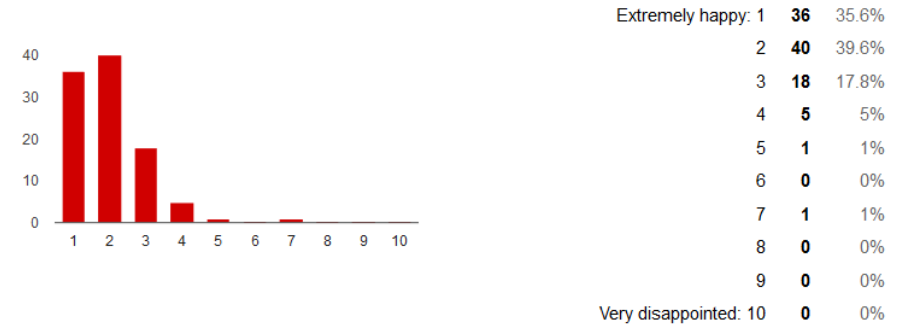

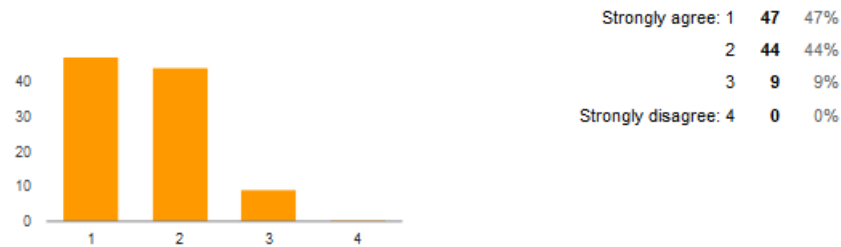

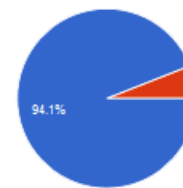
Overall, how happy are you with your child's education?



The school has support systems in place for my child.



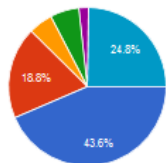
Are you happy with the programmes being taught at school?

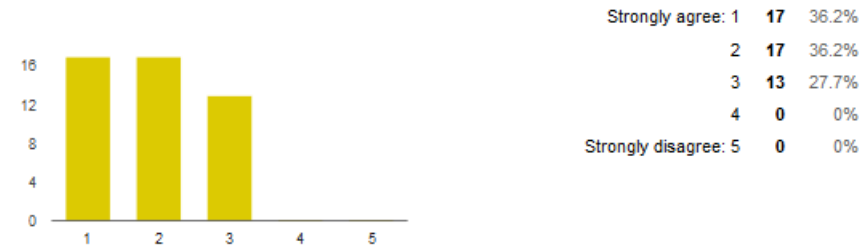
Bullying

I have contacted the school in 2015-2016 about bullying



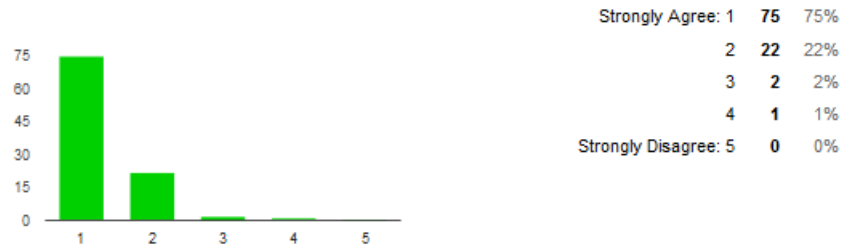

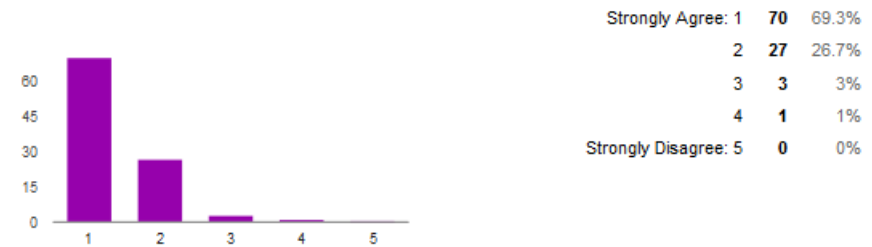

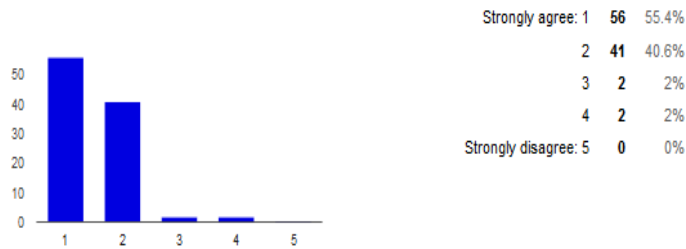

The Principal is approachable

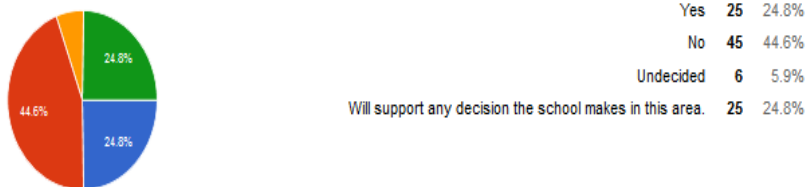

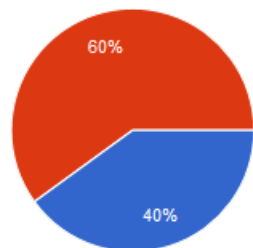
Should Christian Religious Education be at Kaikorai Primary School?



Would you encourage your child to attend a lunchtime programme if CRE was discontinued.



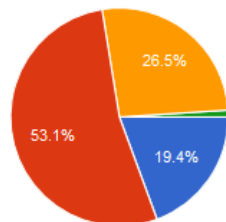
Have you already removed your child from CRE?

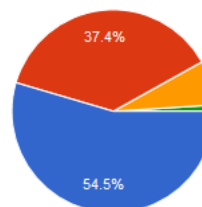

How useful do you find the written reports including National Standards



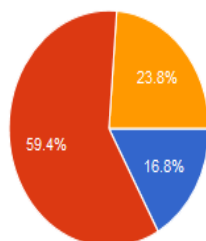

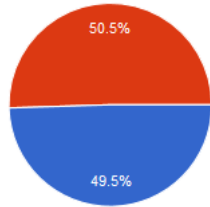
Would you like your child to attend Parent/Teacher interviews

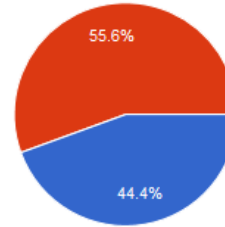

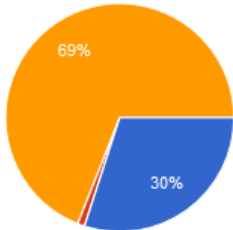
Have you accessed your child's google drive and seen the work they are doing at school.

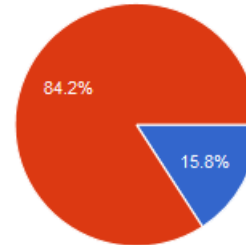
Swimming

Whose responsibility is it to teach children to swim?



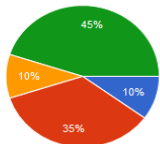

Have you withdrawn you child from swimming lessons in the last 18 months?



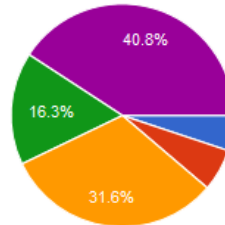
