New Zealand Wetlands film comes to Amberley, June 16

# "Rohe Koreporepo: The Swamp The Sacred Place"

Amberley School Hall, 7 pm, Thursday June 16 followed by discussion with wetlands specialists including Greg Byrnes of Tühaitara Coastal Park Trust (Te Kōhaka o Tühaitara)



In the last 150 years, 90% of Aotearoa's swamps and wetlands have been destroyed in the name of development. Wetlands support rich ecosystems, provide natural flood control and are significant carbon sinks. They have always been regarded as sacred places and mahinga kai food gathering places by Māori tangata whenua.

This documentary, by acclaimed Christchurch filmmaker Kathleen Gallagher, celebrates the efforts of 60 community kaitiaki/guardians around the country to restore and enhance those that remain today, and explains why they are vital for a healthy and balanced future on Papatuanuku/Earth.

# Flu vaccines are available now, protect yourselves & Whanau this winter.

Please ring reception to arrange an appointment.

Vaccines are fully funded if:

- You are 65 years and over
- You are pregnant
- You are an adult or child who have a chronic health condition
- You are Māori and Pacific people aged 55 to 64 years

Non-funded vaccines cost **\$25** for registered adults and children Non-funded vaccines cost **\$36** for non-registered patients.

Remember, immunisation is the best way to protect our communities and Whanau from infection and serious illness. Indications show a resurgence of respiratory viruses, and vaccination against the influenza virus is highly recommended.




