5.35 ACLAND HOUSE - STUDENT USE OF CARS

RATIONALE:

Academic, sporting or cultural activities may require a Year 13 boarder to keep a car at Acland House for a specified time.

PURPOSE:

To have an awareness of and control over motor vehicles kept at Acland House.

GUIDELINES:

- 1. The right to have a car at Acland House will be subject to the Principal's approval and applications must be made to her in writing using the permission form which is available from the Director of Boarding.
- 2. Year 13 students may have unlimited access to their vehicles provided they have parental permission to do so, and provided they operate the vehicles in a safe manner.
- 3. Parents of the driver must complete the appropriate permission form which is available from the Director of Boarding/CGHS before specified passengers are carried.
- 4. Parents will be required to complete the appropriate form or confirm by email for their young person to be a passenger in a vehicle driven by an approved driver to approved venues.
- 5. Responsibility for on and off the road safety of car, driver and passengers will be the full responsibility of the parents.
- 6. Failure to comply with any of the above conditions will result in immediate withdrawal of the privilege and/or other privileges.
- 7. Acland House is not responsible for any damage to cars incurred while they are on the property.
