We have the capacity to accommodate some student cars on site in boarding. Students must apply for this privilege. Car parks will be individually assigned and those students only will have exclusive rights to their park. Priority will be given to Year 13 boarders. Please complete this form and return for our consideration should your daughter wish to apply to have a car at school.

NB: Under no circumstances is a student permitted to bring a car to school without first following the <u>'Vehicle Procedures - Year 12/13 Boarding Students'</u>. Please note: Car keys will be kept in the Senior Boarding office. Girls must seek permission from the staff member on duty to use the vehicle. Students will be given an induction from the Y12/13 House Parent and/or Director of Boarding once this application has been processed.

- I will not allow other students to drive my vehicle.
- As a fully licensed driver, I will not take passengers in my vehicle without first checking with boarding staff that they have permission to travel with me.
- If someone else has parked in my allocated park, I will park in the roundabout until further notice and/or until the car owner is located and has vacated my carpark.
- My vehicle is insured and I am aware that the school takes no responsibility for any damage that may occur to my vehicle while parked in the school grounds.
- I agree to keep the Director of Boarding informed of any changes to the above details.
- I am aware that if my car is not identified with the school ID sticker, and/or it is parked outside the designated areas, I risk losing the privilege of having a car at school.
- I agree to keep myself up to date and comply with any changes to school rules/expectations regarding students and their cars at school.
- I understand that if found in breach of school rules/expectations and/or the law, I may face vehicle use restrictions, loss of privilege and/or a boarding stand down.
- I will only use my vehicle when I have been given permission from my House Parent or the Director of Boarding to do so.

Applicable to Drivers on a Restricted Licence

As a restricted licence driver I understand it is illegal to transport passengers while on a restricted licence and will not do so.
