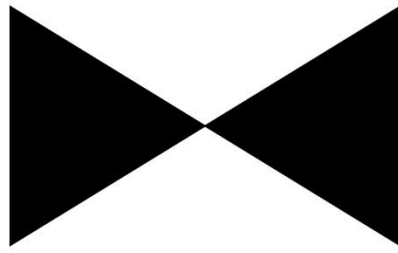

RESCHEDULED WAIAU BRIDGE NIGHT CLOSURE

The previously advertised Waiau night closure was cancelled due to freight issues related to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The new night closure date will be on Friday 18 September to install the final rubber expansion joints. These are custom flexible joints that allow the bridge decks to move. This is the last major repair to be completed on the bridge.

How will this impact me?

Night Closure:

- Friday 18 September, from 8pm until 8am Saturday 19 September.
- Note - the night of Saturday 19 September is a contingency if required.

There will be restricted access for emergency vehicles.

Please note all closures are weather dependent.

Detour

Detour arrows will be set up to divert traffic, via River Road, continuing along Leslie Hills Road onto Mouse Point Road (SH7). This adds an extra 20 - 30 minutes to your journey.

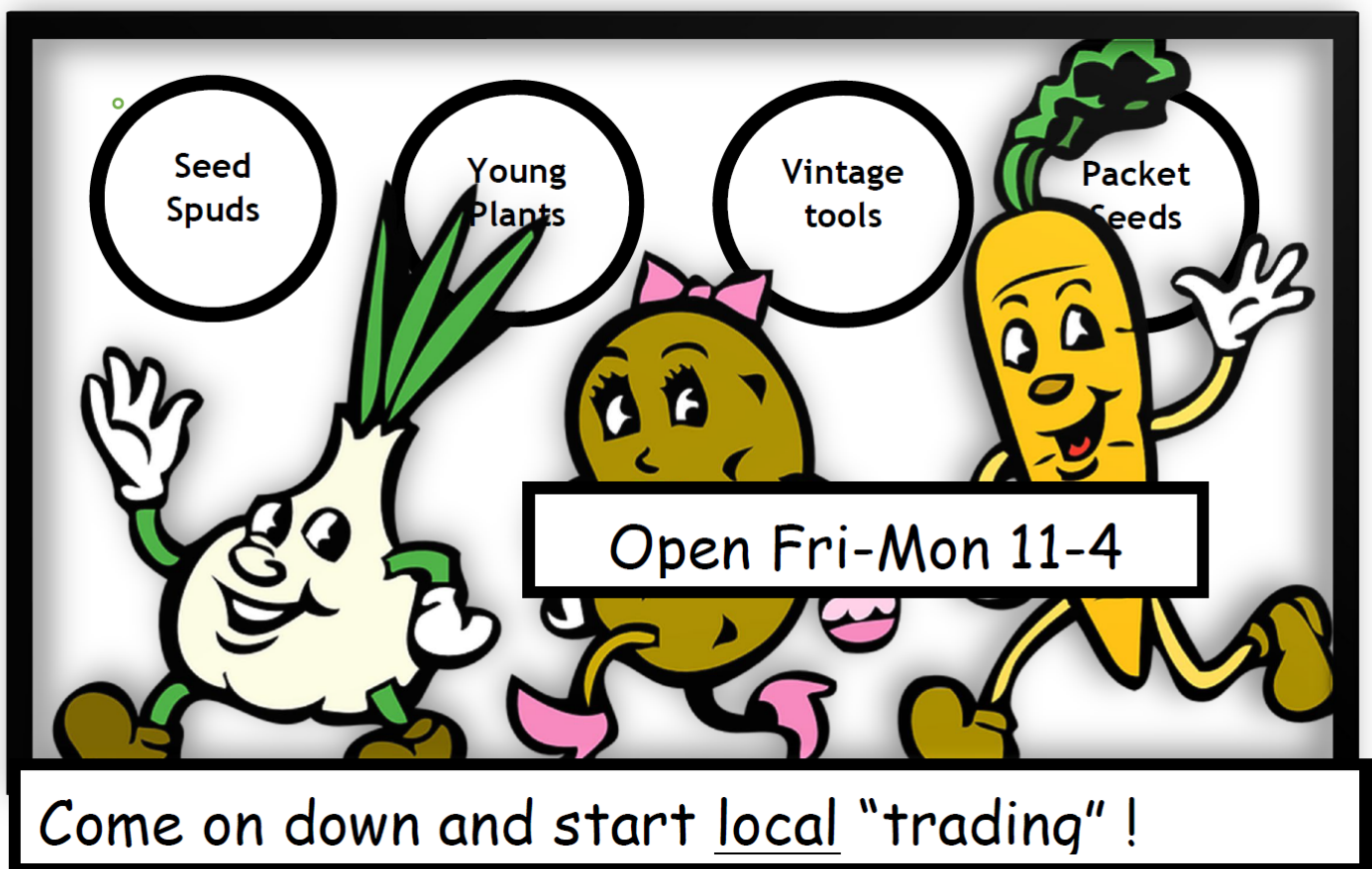
