Dunedin City Council has existing water mains and wastewater sewers in the Kaikorai Valley which are due for renewal, City Care have been contracted to renew this network to prevent old pipes failing further.

This work will involve digging trenches the road surface to install the new pipes. Due to the width of the roads and the location of the wastewater sewer, some temporary road closures will be required to complete the work. Temporary road closures will cover 150m sections at a time and temporary diversions will be in place.

Generally works will take place between 7am and 7pm, Monday – Saturday, with possible Sunday work.

There should be no interruptions to your existing water, wastewater, power, gas or telecommunication services while we undertake this work.

The scope of works includes Wales Street, Fairfax Street, McMillan Street, Lynn Street, Shetland Street, Mount Street, Dale Street, Oban Street and Mardale Street.

Temporary road closures will be publically notified and we will communicate directly with affected residents closer to the time of closing each section of road. Site investigations will start from 18 May and we expect trench excavation work to start in late June.
