Waimakariri District Council Youth Service Awards 2023

Purpose of the Award

To celebrate the contribution and accomplishments of Youth in our Waimakariri district.

Criteria:

- Recognition of the positive impact on the community through their volunteering
- Any person aged 12-24 years who has carried out significant voluntary service in the Waimakariri District to: the arts, culture, education, health, recreation, sport, welfare or youth can be nominated by any two (2) citizens of the Waimakariri District.

The following criteria apply to nominations in respect of awards for Youth Service:

- The nominee must be between 12 and 24 years as of 12 August 2023
- Details of the nominee's achievements and successes are required and must be submitted on the official form.
- Please complete all sections of the form with the required information (including the nominee's current contact details).
- A maximum of two (2) youth awards will be awarded in any given year. The Panel's decision is final. The nominators are encouraged to keep the nomination confidential, as not all nominations will be successful.
- Nominations can be made by individual persons, organisations, associations, societies or clubs – any such group can nominate more than one person for consideration. Two (2) executive officers of the nominating organisation, association, etc. are required to sign the nomination form and record the titles of their office alongside their signatures
- The more detailed the information is that can be supplied about the merits and achievements of the youth, will greatly aid the process. Information supplied should include voluntary work or activities and timeframes.
